

JACK HARRIS 1924

JACK HARRIS' ORKESTER: Bernhard Navitzky, alt. Hansson or Otto Lington, vln. Unknown British pianist or Gunnar Johnsson, pno. Jack Harris, bjo. Arthur Hasseltine, dms. Four titles recorded in Stockholm, December 13, 1924.

The booklet notes for the Swedish release Caprice CD CAP22037 state that Lington is “sannolikt” = “in all probability” present. Thorough research has revealed, however, that it is rather more likely that Danish violinist Otto Lington joined Harris in the spring of 1925 (at Scala Teatret, Copenhagen, performing in the revue "Rosen blusser", April 21 to September 15). He stayed on, mainly in Sweden, until spring 1927. Actually, Lington himself has verbally indicated that he did not meet Harris until 1925 in Copenhagen.

Consequently the discography is not relevant in this context.
